While at Synod Assembly I learned of a fun idea from our neighbors, Trinity Moulton, is doing to help these members remember and kids remember.

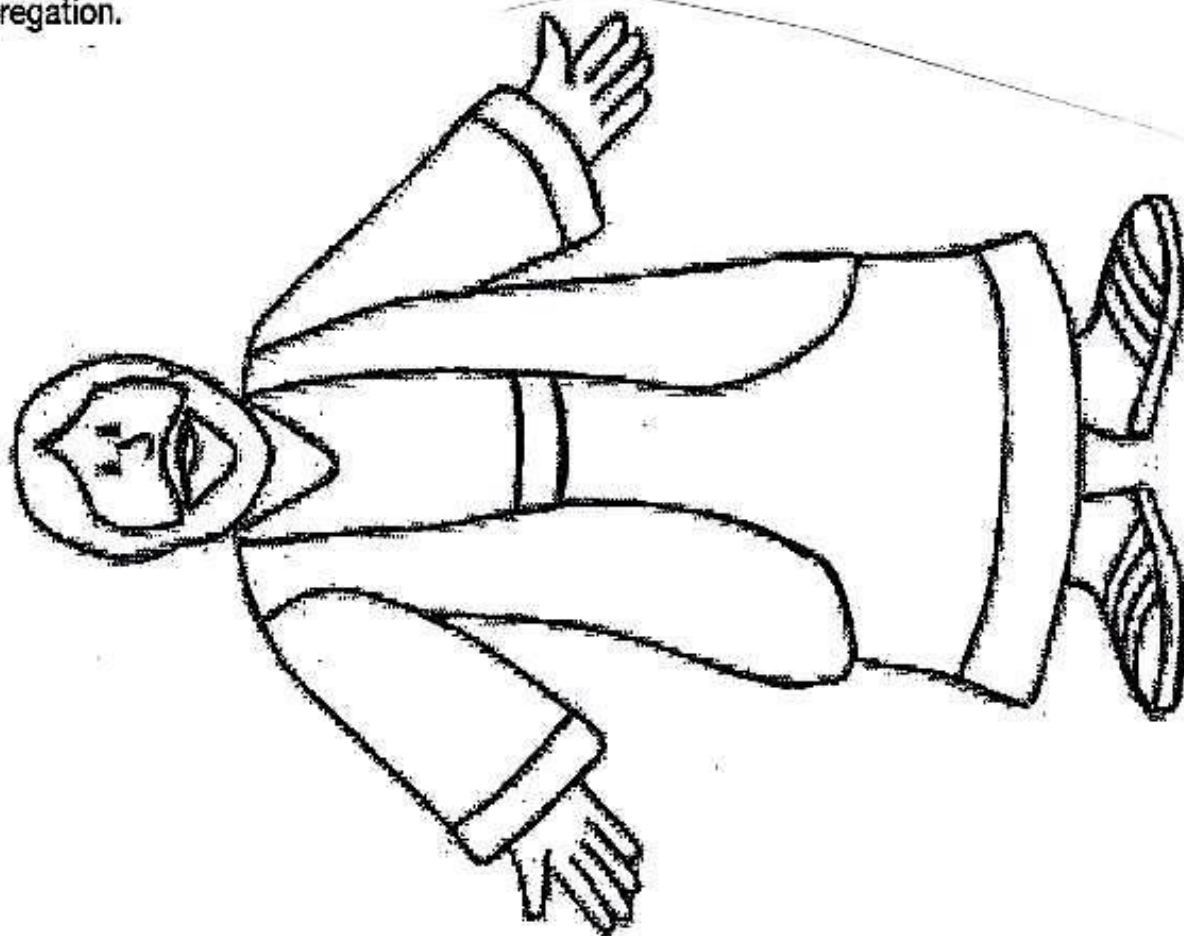
