How do we know the Spirit of God is leading us? What is the Spirit of God? As Lutherans it's hard for us to grasp the Holy Spirit.

I think it's hard because we are generally logical, straightforward, no nonsense people. Now I know not all of us have those characteristics, but certainly these features come through in how Lutheran's behave, worship and go through life. We do not generally shout out during the sermon when we are touched by the message (some may say, moved by the Spirit), we are hesitant to clap or show emotion in worship (or even outside of worship), we don't often lay hands on each other for healing prayer, and regarding praying out loud – the pastor can do that!

So, when we hear Paul and others talk about the Spirit leading us – what exactly is that? It's that nudge or intuition we receive that calls us to action. It's that spontaneous hug or thoughtful gesture you give or receive. But the Holy Spirit also leads us as we sit with God in silent prayer, or when we ask for advice from trusted people of God.

Paul reminds us in Romans 8:15 that we “did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but we have received a spirit of adoption.” The world and the people in the world pull us into the pettiness and also into the greedy nature of our humanness. This slavery and anxiousness keep us from receiving the full love and gifts of God. The Holy Spirit through our silent meditations, through our worship, and through our friends in Christ keep us focused in the love of God! What a gift!

How is the Spirit moving and leading you? What are you being called to? Or what are you being called away from? Take time this early summer, sit in your holy place and intentionally listen for the Spirit? Where is she directing you?

We are children of God, Adopted into God's family through our Baptism in Christ. What a Blessing we have received. Thanks be to God, AMEN! *Vicar Deb Monnin*

First English's Stewardship Corner:


Where is the Holy Spirit working in our Community?

School starts in earnest on June 9 – but I have been in orientation all through the month of May. I have met my professors and my classmates. There are 32 of us in this third MDivX Cohort (Cohort = class or group). We will take all our classes together and will take them all in the same order. This is new for me as I never have been in a school this small! My High School, Napoleon, graduated 206 in my class, and the University of Cincinnati had over 30,000

undergraduate students when I attended oh so long ago. So, this small class and student body is new to me. I'm appreciating the attention and support from the staff and professors at Luther Seminary. I will be taking 4 classes (class times are generally Tuesdays and Thursdays) and they are listed in the plant graphic that you'll find later in the newsletter...ask me about them and you can learn with me. Vicar Deb's Seminary Journey


Thank you - thank you all for your support of me, a student pastor. Thank you for encouraging me and giving me your feedback as we try new things together. My seminary experience begins on June 9 - and I'll be learning and experiencing many new things. I can't wait to share my experiences with you. We are adding this article in our newsletter each month so you know what's going on with my studies.

The first week of every semester is an "Intensive Week". Typically, in that week I would be at Luther Seminary in St Paul, Minnesota learning in person with my classmates and professors. This term we are meeting via zoom on June 9-17. I will have very limited availability that week as I'll be in class almost all of the time, but please do not hesitate to reach out to me or Pastor Melodi if you need pastoral care.

My first semester of classes goes through August 20. I will be in class on Tuesdays and Thursdays and will continue to keep my office hours the same, Monday Mornings and Wednesday Afternoons. However, I will be serving 20 hours a week during seminary rather than the 30 hours a week I've been prior to seminary.

As I'll be learning over these two years, you will be able to learn and grow with me also. As a body of Christ, we are called to support, encourage and pray for each other. Thank you for trying new things and for supporting and encouraging me and each other in ways you might not have in years prior. Announcements from Council

May Council Meeting Highlights

During a special congregational meeting held on May 16th, First English Lutheran Church approved a proposal to replace the existing ductless heating and air conditioning units in the sanctuary. The work will be performed by Perry Heating and Air Conditioning who submitted a bid for \$22,257 to complete the entire project. Perry will begin working in the sanctuary as soon as the parts and materials arrive.

In light of announced changes to the COVID-19 policies and mandates in the state of Ohio, Church Council voted to remove all COVID-19 guidelines and special requirements for activities at FELC effective June 2nd, 2021. This means that FELC will return to pre-COVID practices on June 2nd, with the following exceptions;

- We will continue to rope off one pew on each side of the sanctuary for congregants who wish to continue social distancing practices
- Communion kits will continue to be made available for individuals who wish to commune from their seats
- Our regular and noisy offering will continue to be taken at the back of the sanctuary and chapel overflow area
- We will continue live-streaming our worship services

The independent audit of FELC's 2020 financial records has been completed satisfactorily. Council would like to extend a special thank you to our Treasurer Susan Miller and our Financial Secretary Georgeann Stienecker and the many volunteers who assist them throughout the year for the extreme care and attention to detail that they have always shown in the handling of our financial affairs! Thank you for all that you do for our FELC family!

Thank you to everyone who dreamed with us and shared their ideas for how we might use and update our spaces to the advancement of our mission! Council has reviewed the feedback we received and identified several opportunities that we can begin immediately and a few that will require a bit more research and planning before they are implemented. One of the first projects we plan to tackle is finishing the high school lounge and activity space in the basement. Thank you again for all of your great ideas!

Vicar Deb officially starts her seminary training at Luther Seminary this month. This means that her workload at FELC will be reduced from 30 to 20 hours per week. Vicar Deb plans to keep her same office hours on Monday mornings and Wednesday afternoons and she will continue to be available by phone and email, but please be understanding if she is sometimes unable to provide an immediate response to your questions or concerns. Luther Seminary has requested that Vicar Deb prepare no more than two messages per month so that she might focus on her studies. In order to accommodate this request, we will have one message per month delivered by members of our congregation and another delivered by Pastor Melodi Hagen. A detailed summer schedule has been prepared and is available in the church office. Thank you all for supporting Vicar Deb as she begins this new phase in her call to leadership in Christ Jesus!
