JOB DESCRIPTION Position: Part Time Pianist

Position Purpose: The Pianist gives leadership to the worship services of First English Lutheran Church by using the piano to lift the congregation in music for the praise of God.

Supervision: The Pianist serves under the supervision of the Pastor.

Responsibilities: Subject to review and adjustment in conjunction with the Congregation Council and the Pastor, the following constitute the major responsibilities of the Pianist.

1. Provide piano music at all Sunday worship services, mid-week worship occasions, and all special celebrations of worship where the piano is the primary instrument used.
2. Accompany vocalists and instrumentalists as scheduled by the Choir Director(s)/Pastor.
3. Provide piano music as needed for the weddings and funerals held at the church when the piano is the primary instrument used. Fees for these services are not provided by the church but are honorariums for the couples and families at an amount determined by church policy.
4. Submit information for bulletins in a timely fashion as determined by the Pastor.
5. To be available for choir practice usually 1 time per week.

Working Conditions:

1. The Pianist shall rehearse sufficiently to maintain a high quality of music at the organ/piano.
2. An annual performance review will be done with the Staff Support Committee, with input from the Pastor.
3. Attendance at the Worship and Music Committee meetings is required.
4. Cooperate with all staff and musicians of the congregation so that music ministry is enhanced within the life of the church.

Skills and Qualifications:

1. Sufficient keyboard experience and ability to sight read hymns, liturgy, and anthem accompaniments.
2. Experience as "team player" in a church setting working with the staff, musicians, and volunteers

Salary/Compensation:

1. Salary: Commensurate with experience
2. Insurance: Not applicable
3. Travel: An allowance is negotiable
4. Vacation: Three (3) weeks
