

A Message from Our President

A few weeks ago, you should have received a letter from the church containing information regarding discussions that Church Council has been having about the future direction of the church and how we should move forward following the congregational meeting in August. We have been blessed with some very generous Supply Pastors and lay ministers that have given their time to help lead worship, but we are eager to start the process to call our church's next pastor.

Church Council feels that this time of transition might be the perfect time to consider the possibility of leaving the ELCA in order to eventually join the NALC. The letter contained quite a lot of information about how the ELCA and NALC are alike and also how they are different. If you have not already done so, please take the time to review that information. The letter also noted that the NALC has a more streamlined process to call pastors. This streamlined process has enabled NALC churches to have much shorter waits to call pastors than ELCA churches. As enthusiastic as Council is about the possibility of eventually joining the NALC, the congregation must decide whether to start the process.

For that reason, on December 10, 2023, we will be having two separate congregational meetings. Our first meeting will be at the beginning of worship to vote on new council members for 2024 and to vote on the 2024 budget. The second meeting will take place after worship and the only item on the agenda will be whether to start the process to disaffiliate from the ELCA. It is necessary to have a separate meeting for this vote because our ELCA constitution requires a separate meeting where no other matters are considered. Both meetings will be an in-person only vote requiring participants to complete a written ballot.

Enclosed you will find the agendas for these meetings. We look forward to seeing you at these very important meetings.
