Highlights from Church Council

Council met on June 23,2024, following worship. We did not have a May meeting. Brenda gave the devotion and then we discussed our financial reports. Georgeann answered some questions, regarding our current finances.

Council approved using \$ 1500.00 from the Kantner Scholarship as a donation to the North American Lutheran Seminary.

We then spent 2 and $\frac{1}{2}$ hours comparing different model constitutions, along with our old constitution. Our first task as a council, after changing synods is to prepare a new constitution. Our plan is to finish it at the July meeting and hopefully have the Congregation approve it in August.

Council Update on Call Process

We know that members are wondering how this process is proceeding, so we would like to explain what has been happening. Summer is a time for families to be together and take vacations, so the call process will begin in September officially, but we do have 7 members and 1 alternate who have agreed to be on the call committee. Council will approve these members at our July meeting and then we will announce the names to the congregation. In August, we will ask them to join our council meeting to begin talking about our profile for a new pastor.

On September 15, 2024, Pastor Shelly Schultz who is serving as our NALC call facilitator will be leading our service and then meeting with the call committee and council for call process orientation.

It has always been a fact that attendance and offerings decrease during summer, but we as a council hope everyone can agree that this year, it is extremely important for us to come together and help support our church. If we hope to have even a part-time Pastor, we have to do better than we have been doing in our attendance and offerings.

We hope this helps answer some questions and that everyone realizes that there are a lot of steps involved in this process. Our council is taking these next months very seriously in calling a new Pastor, but we are also asking the congregation for help with understanding, patience and with the attendance and monetary support.
