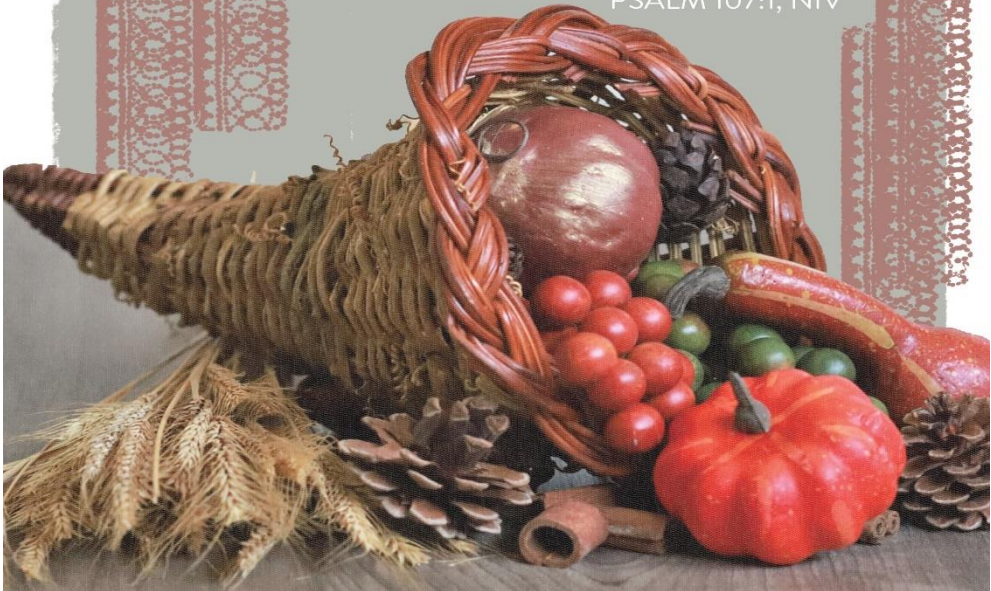

There will be a meeting with finance and chairs of the committees to make sure everyone is doing the proper reimbursement designations. We continued our work to complete our new Constitution. We thank Dave Clift for all his time he is spending trying to make sure it will be ready for the congregation's approval.

We will be having a workshop with Pastor Adam Poe and with a carry in meal at noon on Nov 2. We have worked hard trying to urge everyone in our congregation as to how important it is to have our members show up and help us to have the support we need to choose the right leader. 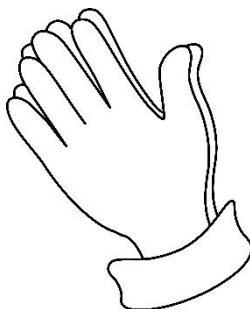

We are a church that needs a pastor, but we are a church together, each with our own gifts/talents to make up a congregation that supports one another together. No one person is left alone to work alone in our church.

- ✗ Call Committee chair contacts the NALC Call Process Coordinator to schedule a conference call for orientation/training.

- ✗ Call Committee engages in Bible Study in the Call Process Manual.  
Meeting on Wednesdays at 6:45pm.
- ✗ Call Committee chair will contact Mission District dean to arrange and complete The Congregational Workshop in preparation for the Call Process.
- ✗ Chair contacts their Mission District dean to arrange and complete the **Congregational Workshop – November 2, 9am-2:00/2:30pm.**
- Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and emails it to the Call Process office.

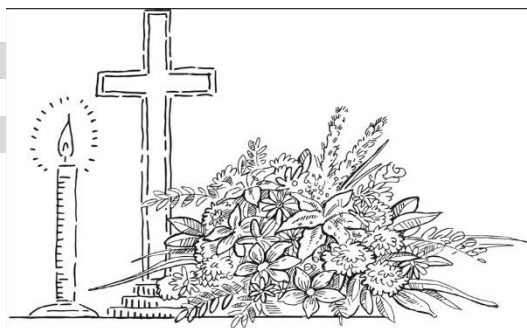

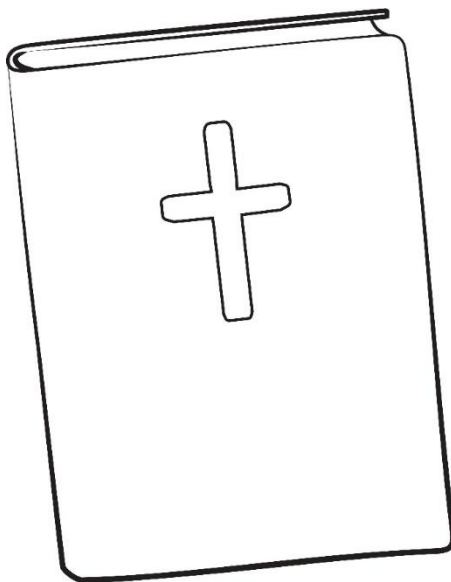
