## JANUARY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

On January 19, 2025, council held their monthly meeting. Brenda established a quorum followed by a devotion from Char Curry. Richard Yocum will do the devotion for the next meeting.

Treasurer, Cari Frame, came in and gave us an update on how QuickBooks was working out and discussing some requests from council on seeing some other helpful reports. Following the business reports, we heard from several committee meeting minutes that were given by the liaisons and one of the highlights from the fellowship meeting was that they will be holding a carry- in meal followed by an egg hunt and visit from the Easter bunny on Palm Sunday. Fellowship is also hoping for a great turnout for the Souper Bowl lunch on Feb 9<sup>th</sup> with all proceeds going to our current fund.

Christian Ed met and discussed plans for first communion and VBS.

We then talked about the lighting project in our sanctuary. Brenda gave an update on Gods Storehouse and the yoga class in FH 3 days a week. She also gave an update on the call committee's work.

We approved the new constitution that is now completed and will be asked for approval by the congregation on Feb 16, 2025. We approved the agenda for this meeting, and it will be sent to everyone around Feb 6.

Marsha Jackson was approved as our volunteer financial secretary.

Council then approved leasing a new copier for the office, the old one's lease is up in May and since it's 5 years old and parts availability was an issue and the numerous service calls, we felt we should update the copier. Perry Pro Tech is actually lowering our payments and putting us into a nonprofit contract, so it will be a nice savings for the church.

Our last discussion was related to the Kantner Scholarship fund. Georgeann informed everyone that the Kantners wished for us to use it, so it was approved to use some of the funds for a robe for Michelle Kouse, who is in the seminary and will be coming 2 times a month. She is now authorized to preside over our communion. This is a huge help for our supply schedule. We also will be giving her \$1,000.00 scholarship toward her schooling.

We then adjourned our meeting. Please contact anyone on council with any comments or questions.

- ★ Chair contacts their Mission District dean to arrange and complete the Congregational Workshop – November 2, 9am-2:00/2:30pm.
- **x** Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and emails it to NALC Call Process.
- **x** Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and video to the NALC website.
- Call Committee develops list of ministry questions to be asked in full interviews. ...
