

MAY COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

On May 18,2025, Council met for our monthly meeting.

A quorum was established, followed by a devotion by Darla Frame.

Cari Frame, our treasurer, came to the meeting to help discuss the financial reports. Several questions were cleared up, so council was able to approve February and March along with April reports.

Last month there were no official committee meetings, but Brenda did give Council an update on some property matters. Our roof leak in the back foyer has been repaired. We are waiting for a bid to paint the brown section on outside of Melching Hall and white trim along Mechanic and Blackhoof Streets. On June 12, Adam's Window Washing will be coming to clean our windows, especially the high ones. Our young man who is mowing the church this year also mulched and trimmed the bushes.

Brenda highly recommends him if anyone would like some lawn care help. In old business discussion, council was informed that our church will be hosting our NALC district for a get together on Saturday September 6. Everyone at our church will be invited to come and meet others in our district. We will be providing a continental breakfast along with lunch. More details will be coming.

On May 5, Chris Coleman, a representative from High Voltage, came to speak to a few of us regarding a new contract for our gas supplier. Our contract had expired so we wanted to make sure we could get the best price. A new 3-year contract was signed locking in a \$ 1.99 transport price. We will reconvene in the fall to reevaluate our commodity price.

Darla, Char and Brenda gave a report on the Spring Convocation that we attended in Springfield. We met other NALC churches and enjoyed attending some workshops.

In New Business, Council approved the motion to offer direct deposit for those receiving payroll checks.

The Kantner scholarship CD was also approved to reinvest.

It has become increasingly difficult for our financial team to offer the tithely giving, so Council voted to discontinue this way of offering.

Our next meeting will be June 22, 2025, following worship.

- ★ Call Committee chair will contact Mission District dean to arrange and complete The Congregational Workshop in preparation for the Call Process.
- ★ Chair contacts their Mission District dean to arrange and complete the Congregational Workshop – November 2, 9am-2:00/2:30pm.
- **x** Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and emails it to NALC Call Process.
- ★ Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and video to the NALC website.
- x Call Committee develops list of ministry questions to be asked in full interviews.
- ... Patiently waiting on God's timing for a Pastor to show interest in Profile.

Interest-free loans for college students the Pierstorf interest-free loans are open to students in all of Ohio. Eligibility: the applicant and/or one parent or guardian must be active members of a Lutheran church in Ohio. The applicant must be enrolled full time in a four-year undergraduate program at an accredited college or university. Applying: application becomes available online on April 15 of each year, with a deadline for complete application submission of June 30. Applications collected during this time period for loans for the upcoming school year (beginning august or September). Borrowers must apply each year to continue to receive their Pierstorf loan.
