 - × Chair contacts their Mission District dean to arrange and complete the Congregational Workshop – November 2, 9am-2:00/2:30pm.
 - × Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and emails it to NALC Call Process.
 - × Call Committee completes the Congregational Profile and video to the NALC website.
 - × Call Committee develops list of ministry questions to be asked in full interviews.

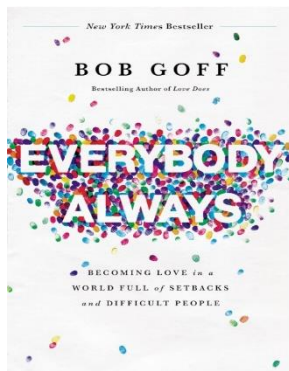

Reformation Sunday is October 26th! Please help us celebrate by **wearing RED!!**



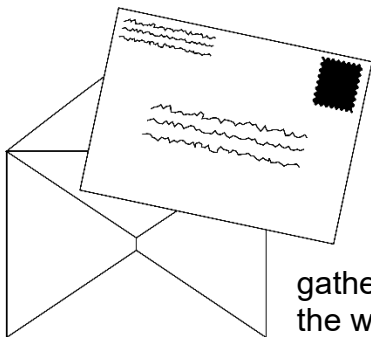
Coming Soon – Book Club We heard everyone, Book Club is coming back!

- Include the name and address of your group or congregation on each box with a label that says:
"A GIFT FROM [name & address of your church or group]"
