We had meetings from Christian Ed and Music & Worship to review by the liaisons. Staff Support has met with the staff and heard favorable results. They will meet with Pastor Lorenzo soon.

Evangelism/Social Ministry and finance along with Property will be meeting very soon.

In old business, we spent time going through and discussing our constitution and we all, along with the Pastor, feel strongly that 3 amendments should be added, so we will be working on those.

In new business, our lawn and snow removal man has resigned. We will be looking for a new snow removal person so any suggestions will be appreciated. For this summer, Marc Shoffstall will be doing the mowing.

We have an 8-person team for Kids Against Hunger that Grace Lutheran and Trinity are sponsoring on May 27.

The Annual report was amended to state that Jacob Schlosser and Frankie Yocum received 1<sup>st</sup> Communion in 2025.

We discussed at great lengths the deteriorating condition of the outside and inside of our chapel and courtyard and library of the church. After showing it to council and Pastor, we all agreed now is the time to have this work done.

We have a bid from Trisco Systems that comes highly recommended. Finance and property committees are also involved in this project, and we will be holding a congregational meeting on May 24<sup>th</sup>.

We then adjourned the meeting. Next council meeting will follow the congregational meeting on the May 24<sup>th</sup>.

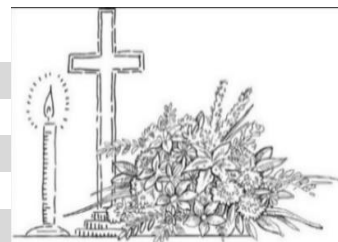
